## **INDUSTRIAL REVOLUTION PROJECT – "GOLF" Scoring Method**

In golf, you want to get the ball in each hole with the least amount of "strokes" (swings) as possible. You need to MAKE par (**assignment minimum points – 200 points**), BELOW par (extra credit points), OR ADD a "handicap" to make par (only needed if ABOVE par). Therefore, as long as you are at or below par, you do not need to complete activities for a handicap.
