

INDUSTRIAL REVOLUTION PROJECT – “GOLF” Scoring Method

In golf, you want to get the ball in each hole with the least amount of “strokes” (swings) as possible. You need to **MAKE** par (**assignment minimum points – 200 points**), **BELOW** par (extra credit points), **OR ADD** a “handicap” to make par (only needed if **ABOVE** par). Therefore, as long as you are at or below par, you do not need to complete activities for a handicap.

GOLF STROKE(S)	PROJECT	POINTS POSSIBLE
Par = # of strokes to get ball in hole	Use the Industrial Revolution template to FULLY complete a 20 slide presentation. Use the template to add information, pictures, color, etc.	200
Bogey – 1 stroke above par	Find pictures (or create your own) of working conditions of the industrial revolution age (1800s) and photos from our current time. Photos can show child labor, factories, housing, etc. Put them in a collage (minimum 20 pictures) that includes captions with each of your pictures that provide a description of the images.	150
Double Bogey – 2 strokes above par	Poor and crowded living conditions during the IR led to the spread of many illnesses (esp. cholera). Research cause, symptoms, and treatments for cholera and then CREATE a public service campaign to educate others – brochures, video, posters, commercials, etc.	125
Birdie – 1 stroke below par	Glogster or Prezi: Research 10 important inventions/inventors (explain what each their invention was, its impact on the industrial revolution, etc. – must include pictures & information about scientist/inventor)	225
Eagle – 2 strokes below par	Write and produce a 3-5 minute movie based on the life of someone living during the IR. The person can be a member of working poor, a wealthy capitalist, a middle class individual, a child laborer, etc. You can act out the movie or use software to produce it.	250
Albatross – 3 below par	Working conditions still vary wildly depending on the work being performed and the area in which the work is located. Research global companies that have a good reputation for high quality working conditions. Create a top ten list of modern companies, define your selection criteria (why you chose those companies) and create a recruitment advertisement for on the companies (commercial, poster, etc.)	275
Hole In One	Create a 5 page website that contains specific information and images/videos, etc. of the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - home page: introduction of what the IR was (when, where, why, etc.) - 5 important people (brief bios & explain how they are important to the IR) 	300

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 3 inventions & how they impacted the IR - Explain “Quality of Life” during the IR - Research the causes, symptoms, and treatments for cholera 	
Handicap – strokes needed to make par	<p>~ Imagine you are living during the early years of the IR and write at least 3 (3-5 sentence) diary entries as one of the following people – factory worker, child laborer, working class mother, etc. Be sure to include events of your day and details about your life. You need to include not only observations and activities, but also your feelings and emotions about what are occurring.</p> <p>~ Poster on the causes, symptoms, and treatments for cholera (include pictures, graphs, etc.)</p> <p>~ Create a timeline of 10 IR events, inventions, etc., with pictures and explanation of event</p>	25 points each

When researching, be sure do the following:

- CITE the resources you found the information (use bibme.org to cite correctly)
- Research (who, what, when, where, why, how, etc.) as MUCH information you can find about your topic. REMEMBER RESEARCH is 50% of your grade!!
